

LOCAL RULES

OUT OF BOUNDS

A ball is out of bounds if it lies beyond boundary fences or any white stakes marking the boundary of the hole being played. **The only exception is on hole 16 where the penalty area extends indefinitely over the fence on the right.**

On or over estate roads.

Within private residences. (No ball may be retrieved from these areas)

An alternative to stroke and distance is available whereby golfers have the option to drop the ball in the vicinity of where the ball is lost or out of bounds (including the nearest fairway area), under a two-stroke penalty.

PENALTY AREAS

Penalty areas are marked with red stakes.

It is not necessary to play a provisional ball off the tee if a player's ball has entered these areas. If the player cannot find their ball, a two club length drop may be taken from the point of entry not nearer the hole.

ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE AREAS (ESA)

On holes 8, 9, 16, 17 & 18 the lagoon side of the hole demarcated by red stakes with green tops is an environmentally protected area.

ENTRY INTO AND/OR PLAY FROM THESE AREAS IS PROHIBITED.

Should you be unsure if your ball has cleared the ESA from the 9th tee you should play a provisional ball.

Should you be unsure if you will find your ball having cleared the dam from the 13th tee you should play a provisional ball.

If a sprinkler head or another immovable obstruction next to the green interferes with the line of play and the ball lies within two club lengths of the green and not in a penalty area or bunker, the ball may be dropped without penalty at the nearest point where there is no interference by the sprinkler head, not nearer the hole. The ball may be cleaned before dropped.

 Hole 5 - 69 mins
 Halfway - 2 hrs 19 mins
 Hole 14 - 3 hrs 28 mins
 Hole 18 - 4 hrs 20 mins
